Key Differences

Metering Box: A meter box is an enclosure designed to house the electricity meter and related service connections. It acts as the interface between the utility power supply and the consumer's internal electrical system, allowing for accurate measurement of energy consumption for billing purposes. Meter boxes are typically installed at the point of entry or on exterior walls, providing easy access for meter reading, inspection, and maintenance. They protect the meter from weather, tampering, and accidental contact while ensuring authorized utility access .

Distribution Box: A distribution box, on the other hand, receives power from the main supply (often downstream of the meter box) and distributes it to multiple branch circuits within a building. It houses protective devices such as MCBs, RCCBs, or RCBOs to safeguard circuits against overloads, short circuits, and leakage currents. Distribution boxes are usually installed indoors, in service rooms or accessible locations, and are essential for controlling and managing electrical flow to lighting, appliances, and equipment .
