

Lighting connection to the third-level distribution box

Lighting power cable must be put in sturdy galvanized conduit after exiting the cable ladder and connected to the lighting fixture via appropriate size FRP termination boxes. The conduits must be securely fastened to the supporting channel using an approved conduit clamp. (1) Power distribution from the primary main distribution board (distribution cabinet) to secondary distribution boards can be branched; that is, one main distribution board may supply power via multiple branch circuits to several secondary distribution boards.
