Steps for Connecting Lighting Wires

1. **Select Appropriate Wires:** Choose wires that match the lighting load and comply with national electrical safety standards. The wires should have sufficient insulation and heat resistance to prevent hazards and ensure long-term reliability . 2. **Prepare the Distribution Box:** Ensure the distribution box is installed in a dry, ventilated, and accessible location. The box should contain MCBs for each lighting subcircuit, an RCCB for leakage protection, and terminal blocks for secure connections . 3. **Connect Phase, Neutral, and Earth:**

- o Phase wires from the lighting circuits are connected to the MCB terminals.

- o Neutral wires are connected to the neutral link inside the distribution box.

- o Earth wires are connected to the earth link, which should be properly earthed to an earth rod or pit . 4. **Use Terminal Blocks:** Secure the wires using terminal blocks that match the wire specifications. Tighten screws or crimp connections to ensure good conductivity and prevent loose connections . 5. **Label and Organize Wires:** Mark each wire clearly to identify the corresponding lighting circuit. Arrange wires neatly inside the box, using ties to prevent tangling and allow heat dissipation . 6. **Test the Circuit:** After wiring, perform insulation resistance tests and check each circuit with a multimeter to ensure there are no short circuits or broken connections. Verify that the MCBs and RCCB operate correctly . 7. **Final Safety Checks:** Ensure all terminals are tightened, the box is closed properly, and the installation complies with electrical safety standards. Confirm that earthing is effective to protect against electric shock . By following these steps, lighting wires can be safely and efficiently connected to a distribution box, providing reliable power distribution and protection for all lighting circuits.
