

Main wiring strip at the top of the distribution box

Article Overview

The wiring strip at the top of a distribution box is typically the main terminal or bus bar where the incoming power is connected and distributed to the circuit breakers.

Function and Placement

The wiring strip, often called the main bus bar or terminal strip, serves as the central point for incoming electrical power. In most distribution boxes, the main breaker is located at the top, and the incoming live (phase) and neutral wires are connected to this strip. From here, power is distributed to individual circuit breakers or protective devices, ensuring each circuit receives electricity safely and efficiently .

Components Connected to the Wiring Strip

- o Main MCB or Main Switch: The incoming supply (phase and neutral) is connected to the main breaker, which is usually positioned at the top of the panel .
- o Neutral Link: A neutral bus bar distributes the neutral wire to all output circuits. When single-pole MCBs are used, the neutral of each load connects to this strip .
- o Earth Link: The earthing terminal is often mounted near the top or side, connecting all protective earth wires to ensure safety .

Wiring Procedure

- o Turn off the main power before starting any connections to prevent electric shock .
- o Secure the distribution box at an accessible height, typically around 1.5 meters, in a dry and ventilated area .
- o Connect the incoming live wire to the main terminal on the wiring strip. The neutral wire is connected to the neutral bus bar.
- o Position the circuit breakers in their slots and connect each outgoing circuit wire to the corresponding breaker. The neutral wires of these circuits are connected to the neutral strip, and earth wires to the earth link .
- o Check all connections with a multimeter to ensure there are no loose connections or short circuits before powering on .

Safety Considerations

- o Use proper wire gauge and insulation for all connections.
- o Ensure tight and secure connections to prevent overheating or arcing.
- o Label all wires and breakers for easy identification and future maintenance .
