Certifications and Standards

Explosion-proof boxes must comply with international standards such as IEC 60079 series, IECEx, and ATEX, which define requirements for flameproof and intrinsically safe equipment . In Korea, the KCs Ex certification is mandatory for electrical components used in explosive environments, regulated by the Korea Occupational Safety and Health Agency (KOSHA). This certification ensures that the equipment meets safety requirements and undergoes regular inspections every two years . Manufacturers with valid IECEx certificates may simplify the KCs Ex certification process, though additional testing may still be required for minor product variations.

Features

Modern explosion-proof distribution boxes often include:

- o High flameproof class (up to IIC) for maximum protection against explosive gases .
- o Wide voltage operation (AC100-250V) and resistance to voltage fluctuations.
- o Long service life (up to 50,000 hours) and maintenance-free operation.
