Power Capacity

The power capacity of a household distribution box is determined by its main breaker rating, which typically ranges from 100A to 200A for standard residential homes. The total power in watts can be estimated using the formula: $\text{Power (W)} = \text{Voltage (V)} \times \text{Current (A)}$ For example, in a 240V system with a 100A main breaker, the maximum power is approximately 24,000 watts. Larger homes or those with high-power appliances may require a 200A panel, supporting up to 48,000 watts .

- o Bus Bars: Conduct electricity from the main supply to each circuit breaker efficiently .
- o Neutral and Ground Bars: Ensure safe return paths for current and prevent electric shocks .
- o Fuses and Safety Devices: Provide additional protection against surges and faults .
