Connecting fiber optic internet to a home requires proper external infrastructure, an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), internal cabling, and compatible networking equipment.

External Connection

Fiber optic service begins at a local distribution point, such as a street cabinet or junction box, and is delivered to your home either underground or aerially. Underground installation involves trenching from the street to your property, while aerial installation uses utility poles to carry the fiber line. The provider is responsible for bringing the fiber to a designated entry point on your property, typically near existing utility lines .

Optical Network Terminal (ONT)

At the entry point, the fiber connects to an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which converts light signals from the fiber into data your devices can use. The ONT requires a dedicated power source, often near your electrical panel, and serves as the central hub for distributing internet throughout your home .

Internal Wiring

From the ONT, a Cat6 or higher Ethernet cable is typically run to your router. For optimal performance, the cable should follow the shortest and straightest path possible, avoiding sharp bends, heat sources, or high-traffic areas. Pre-terminated single-mode fiber cables with SC/APC or LC connectors are commonly used for residential installations to simplify setup and reduce signal loss .

Equipment and Network Setup

- o Router: Distributes Wi-Fi to devices; placement affects coverage and speed.
- o Optional UPS/Surge Protection: Protects the ONT and router from power interruptions.
- o Network Interface Device (NID): Sometimes used as a junction between external fiber and internal wiring .

Preparation Steps

- o Check fiber availability in your neighborhood with your ISP.
- o Clear access points such as driveways, yards, or walls where the fiber will be routed.
- o Plan the ONT location near power and networking equipment.
- o Coordinate with the technician to determine whether existing conduits can be used or if new pathways are needed .



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Installation Timeline

Residential fiber installations typically take 2-6 hours, depending on property complexity. Larger or multi-unit buildings may require additional planning and longer installation times .
