Singapore is one of the more expensive cities in the world, with high costs for housing, food, and daily expenses.

General Cost Overview

The estimated monthly cost for a single person living in Singapore, excluding rent, is approximately S\$1,501.8 (USD \$1,162), while a family of four can expect to spend around S\$5,510.3 (USD \$4,263.6) per month, excluding rent. Overall, the cost of living in Singapore is about 30% higher than in the United States, and rent is nearly 87% higher than the U.S. average.

Utilities, including electricity, water, and internet, are additional costs that vary depending on usage and housing type.
