A primary distribution box typically includes a main switch, circuit breakers, busbars, residual current devices, neutral and earth busbars, and an enclosure for safe power distribution.

Key Components

Main Switch: Controls the overall power supply entering the distribution box, allowing complete disconnection for maintenance or emergencies . **Circuit Breakers (MCBs or MCCBs):** Protect individual circuits from overloads and short circuits by automatically cutting off power when faults occur . **Residual Current Device (RCD) or Residual Current Circuit Breaker (RCCB):** Detects leakage currents and prevents electric shocks, enhancing user safety . **Busbars:** Conductive metal strips, usually copper or aluminum, that distribute electricity from the main switch to multiple branch circuits efficiently and reliably . **Neutral Busbar:** Connects all neutral wires from the circuits, ensuring proper return paths for current . **Earth Busbar:** Provides a grounding point for all earth wires, protecting against electrical faults and ensuring safety . **Enclosure:** The protective casing, made of metal or engineering plastics, shields internal components from mechanical damage, dust, and accidental contact. It may have an IP rating depending on the installation environment . **Indication Lights (optional):** Show the status of mains power supply and operational conditions . **Additional Components in Advanced Boxes:** Some modern or smart distribution boxes may include energy monitoring units, communication modules, or RCBOs (combined RCD and MCB) for enhanced control and monitoring .

- o **Single-Phase Distribution Boxes:** Typically include one phase, one neutral, one earth, a main switch, and multiple MCBs or RCBOs for branch circuits .
- o **Three-Phase Distribution Boxes:** Include three phase conductors (L1, L2, L3), neutral, earth, a three-phase busbar system, and a higher-capacity main switch or MCCB to handle industrial or high-load applications . These components work together to ensure safe, organized, and efficient distribution of electrical power across all circuits in a building or facility, while providing protection against overloads, short circuits, and electrical faults .
