A red LOS (Loss of Signal) light on your fiber optic router indicates that the device is not receiving a proper optical signal from your ISP, often due to cable issues, service outages, or router faults.

Common Causes

- o Inspect the Fiber Cable: Ensure the fiber optic cable is undamaged, properly connected, and not sharply bent. Reseat the connector gently if needed .
- o Power Cycle the Router/ONT: Turn off the device, wait about 20 seconds, then power it back on. Allow a few minutes for the system to boot fully .
- o Check Connections: Confirm that all cables are securely plugged into the correct ports (WAN/ONT for internet, LAN for devices), .
- o Router Settings and Firmware: If the red light persists, log into the router's admin panel to check for configuration errors or firmware updates .
- o Contact ISP Support: If the LOS light remains red after these steps, the issue may be on the line side, requiring technician inspection or service verification .

Additional Notes

- o A red LOS light is different from slow Wi-Fi or buffering; it usually indicates a signal-side problem rather than a minor in-home network issue .
- o Avoid bending or pulling the fiber cable, as even slight damage can prevent the router from receiving a proper signal . Following these steps should help identify whether the problem is local (cables, router) or



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external (ISP outage), and guide you toward restoring your fiber optic internet connection.
