 - o Typical attenuation: ~0.40 dB/km at 1310 nm and ~0.30 dB/km at 1550 nm.
 - o Supports high-speed data transmission: up to 1 Gbps over 80 km and 10 Gbps over 40 km.
 - o Durable and suitable for both indoor and outdoor environments, including aerial, buried, or plenum installations. In summary, the single-mode 9125 fiber can be either OS1 or OS2, but for modern high-performance and long-distance applications, OS2 is the preferred standard due to its lower attenuation and extended reach.
