Circuit Breakers (MCBs): Protect individual circuits from overloads and short circuits by automatically disconnecting power when a fault occurs, preventing damage to equipment and wiring . **Residual Current Circuit Breakers (RCCBs):** Detect imbalances between live and neutral conductors to prevent electric shocks, providing enhanced safety for personnel on site . **Isolators:** Manually operated switches that allow electricians to safely disconnect parts of the circuit for maintenance or repairs . **Bus Bars:** Metal strips that distribute electricity within the box, serving as central connection points for multiple circuits . **Neutral Link:** Provides a return path for current, ensuring proper circuit operation . **Grounding Bus Bar:** Offers a safe path for excess current to flow into the ground during faults, reducing the risk of electric shock or fire . **Surge Protective Devices (SPDs):** Protect the system from voltage spikes caused by lightning or phase-to-phase faults . **Indication Lights:** Visual indicators showing the status of mains power and circuit operation, aiding in monitoring and troubleshooting . **Enclosure:** The outer casing, often made of thermoplastics like polycarbonate or ASA, or powder-coated stainless steel, protects internal components from dust, moisture, and mechanical damage. Many enclosures are rated IP65 or higher for outdoor use .
