A busbar's main function is to conduct and distribute large electrical currents from one source to multiple circuits within an enclosure, acting as a central, high-capacity connection point. My insights show that understanding the practical function is key. In the "childhood" of electricity no separate protection was used for the busbars. However, a specific busbar may have multiple bus segments, with individual circuits that connect to different bus segments depending on operating needs.
