Modern portable boxes may use IP67-rated connectors for additional protection against rain and temporary immersion . Proper installation includes elevating the box off the ground, keeping it away from high-traffic areas, and ensuring clear labeling of circuits .

Installation and Planning

- o Load Assessment: Calculate total power requirements, including peak loads and simultaneous usage of machinery .
- o Phase Balancing: Distribute single-phase loads evenly to avoid neutral overloading .
- o Cable Selection: Use durable cables such as rubber, PVC, or H07RN-F, and consider cable drums to prevent trip hazards .

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- o Connection Coordination: Early coordination with the utility or grid operator ensures adequate capacity, metering, and compliance with local codes .
- o Mobility: Many distribution boxes are portable, allowing relocation as the site layout changes .

The main distribution box supports both three-phase (typically 400 V) and single-phase (typically 230 V) power, accommodating heavy machinery and smaller tools . It also allows for sub-distributions in different work zones, ensuring organized and reliable power delivery throughout the construction phases .
