SPDs protect the electrical system from voltage spikes caused by lightning strikes or switching surges. They divert excess voltage to the ground, preventing damage to appliances and wiring .

Additional Components

- o Busbars: Metal strips that distribute power to multiple circuits within the box .
- o Neutral and Earth Bars: Provide return paths for current and grounding for safety .
- o Fuses: Older systems may still use fuses instead of MCBs, which blow when current exceeds a limit .

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- o Transfer Switches: Used in systems with backup generators to switch between utility and generator power, including automatic transfer switches (ATS) for critical applications .
- o Indicators and Meters: Some modern distribution boxes include energy meters, ammeters, voltmeters, and status lights for monitoring electrical parameters .
