



# Which switch should be pressed to turn off the circuit breaker in the distribution box

## Preview

Turning off power to your breaker box involves locating the main disconnect switch within the panel and carefully switching it to the "OFF" position, a critical safety procedure for electrical work or emergencies. If a breaker handle is resting in the middle position, it has 'tripped' due to a circuit overload and must be fully. Simply flipping the wall switch to the 'off' position only interrupts the flow of power through the hot wire to the fixture, but the wiring inside the box remains live. Failing to cut all power at the source creates an immediate and serious shock hazard. Electrical safety protocols require. The first action is to methodically switch off every single individual branch circuit breaker in the panel.

Breaker switches are ON when toggled toward the center (the busbar) and OFF when toggled toward the outside of
