

Why is my fiber optic router not working

- o **Service Outages:** Check your provider's service status page or social media for local outages. Tools like Downtdetector can provide real-time reports .
- o **Environmental Interference:** Extreme temperatures, moisture, or nearby electronic devices can affect signal quality .

Step 5: Advanced Troubleshooting

- o **Clean Connectors:** Use lint-free wipes and isopropyl alcohol to clean fiber connectors if dirty .



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- o Test Signal Strength: Use an optical power meter or OTDR to measure signal loss. Values outside the recommended range (-15dBm to -30dBm) indicate a problem .
- o Swap Hardware: If possible, replace the router or transceivers with known-good units to isolate faulty equipment .

Step 6: Contact Your ISP

If the above steps do not resolve the issue, contact your internet service provider. They can remotely diagnose problems, send a technician, or replace faulty equipment .
