

Wiring distance in distribution box

Article Overview

The recommended wiring distance from a distribution box to connected switch boxes or equipment is generally up to 30 meters, with internal wiring arranged neatly for safety and maintenance.

External Wiring Distance

For safe and efficient operation, the distance between the distribution box and the switch box should not exceed 30 meters, while the horizontal distance between the switch box and the fixed electrical equipment it controls should generally be within 3 meters . This ensures minimal voltage drop, reduces the risk of overheating, and maintains proper circuit protection.

Internal Wiring Guidelines

Inside the distribution box, wires should be organized and separated by type: phase lines, neutral lines, and protective grounding wires. Each wire should be securely connected to its respective terminal block or busbar, and neat cable management should be practiced using zip ties or cable ducts to prevent tangling and allow heat dissipation .

- o Wire gauge must match the load current requirements, and high-temperature resistant copper wires are recommended .
- o Insulation should be intact, with no exposed copper, and all connections should be tightened to avoid loose contacts .
- o Spacing inside the box should allow for ventilation and easy access for maintenance or future upgrades .

Installation Considerations

- o Install the distribution box in a dry, ventilated, and accessible location, typically 1.5-1.8 meters above the ground for easy operation and inspection .
- o Ensure proper grounding of the metal box, electrical installation board, and all internal components .
- o Use breakers and fuses with correct ratings, and follow the wiring diagram to avoid reverse connections or short circuits .
