

Wiring of the distribution box and the meter box

Article Overview

Proper wiring of a distribution box and electric meter ensures safe power distribution, accurate metering, and compliance with electrical codes.

Core Components

A typical residential electric meter and distribution setup includes the following components :

- o Electric Meter: Measures electricity consumption; has incoming line terminals (Line) and outgoing terminals (Load).
- o Main Circuit Breaker: Controls total power supply and trips during overload or short circuits.
- o Neutral Bar: Connects all neutral wires (N).
- o Ground Bar: Connects the ground wire (PE) and links to a grounding rod.
- o Branch Circuit Breakers: Manage individual circuits such as lighting, outlets, and appliances.

Wiring Steps for Single-Phase (220V)

- o Safety First: Disconnect the main supply before working on the meter or distribution box to prevent arc faults .
- o Incoming Line Connection:
 - o Live Wire (Hot): Black or red wire connected to the L1 terminal of the meter.
 - o Neutral Wire: White or blue wire connected to the N terminal of the meter.
 - o Ground Wire: Green or bare wire connected to the grounding terminal and linked to an 8-foot copper ground rod.
- o Main Breaker Connection: From the meter's load side, feed the main breaker in the distribution panel using appropriately rated conductors.
- o Branch Circuits:
 - o Single-pole breakers for 15-20A lighting and outlet circuits.
 - o Double-pole breakers for 240V appliances, connected across both phases.
- o Neutral and Grounding:
 - o Neutral bar bonded to the metallic chassis only in the main panel.
 - o Subpanels must isolate neutral and ground to prevent circulating currents.
- o Labeling and Testing: Clearly label all breakers and terminals. Perform continuity tests before utility hookup .

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Wiring for Three-Phase (380V)

- o Connect three hot wires (L1, L2, L3) to the meter's line terminals.
- o Neutral and ground connections follow the same principles as single-phase.
- o Branch circuits may include three-phase breakers for heavy loads.

Additional Considerations

- o Use color coding consistently: black/red for hot, white for neutral, green/bare for ground.
- o Ensure proper torque on lugs (e.g., 250 inch-pounds for main connections).
- o Use appropriate conduit (e.g., Schedule 80 PVC) and secure cables every 3 feet.
- o Follow local electrical codes and NEC Article 230 for safety and compliance .
- o Ensure utility access to the meter for inspection and maintenance . Correct installation guarantees safe, reliable power distribution, prevents hazards, and ensures accurate metering for billing and energy management. Always consult a licensed electrician for on-site installation.
